## GRAY MATTER

EMMYLOU HARRIS AND MIRANDA PRIESTLEY may have found the silver lining in going gray; the rest of us still obsess about camo-ing every strand.

“Bangs are the easiest way to distract from a graying hairline,” says **Manhattan hairstylist Eva Scrivo**, who also suggests switching your part to the other side when grow-out (gray or otherwise) appears. Short-term, shampoo-out solutions abound: Colored hair powders, such as those by Psssssst and Bumble and bumble, spray on to disguise roots instantly; Colormark Professional (bottom, in Really Red) is a liquid tint that brushes on with a lip-gloss-style wand; and, according to NYC’s Harry Josh, Roux ‘Tween Time (below left, in Auburn) “masks perfectly for an evening...just make sure you don’t get wet!” For those with only a handful of grays, there’s no need to color the whole lot—hairstylists keep Sharpies (below right) on hand to scribble out rogue strands.
